Recipe Corner Christmas Cookie Dough Dip

- ◆ 1/2 cup Non-Fat Vanilla Yogurt
- ◆ 5 tablespoons of butter softened
- ◆ 2 ounces of cream cheese softened
- ◆ 1/4 cup of flour
- ◆ 1/2 cup of powdered sugar
- ◆ 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ◆ 1/2 cup holiday sprinkles
- ◆ Graham crackers, fruit etc. for dipping

Directions:

1. Place the butter, cream cheese and sugar in a medium bowl. Beat the mixture until light and fluffy
2. Add the flour and vanilla extract and beat for another minute.
3. Add the yogurt, 1/4 cup at a time and mix on low to combine.
4. Stir in the sprinkles, Place the remaining sprinkles on top of the dip for decoration.
5. Serve immediately with fruit, graham crackers and other dippers.

Tree Lights - Only use indoor lights on your indoor trees. Check for broken bulbs, cracked sockets, or frayed wires. Do not use more than three light sets per extension cord.

Ornaments - Always use a proper step stool to reach high places. Avoid placing breakable tree ornaments with children present. Never place lighted candles on a tree or near any flammable material.

Reminder: please do not put your Christmas tree in the regular trash. We will provide an open top container for Christmas trees.
